### **TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS/KEY**

#### **Instructions**

1. **Objective:** Students individually practice their knowledge of civics terms by giving one-word answers to clues, then finding those words in a word search puzzle.
2. Hand out a copy of Page 2 to each student.
3. Tell students they have 15 minutes to complete! (If they want, they can check their notes or civics book for answers to the clues.)
4. When students are finished, discuss **as a class**. Ask for volunteers!
