

Civics: A Christian Worldview. Crossword Puzzle 3 (15–20 minutes)

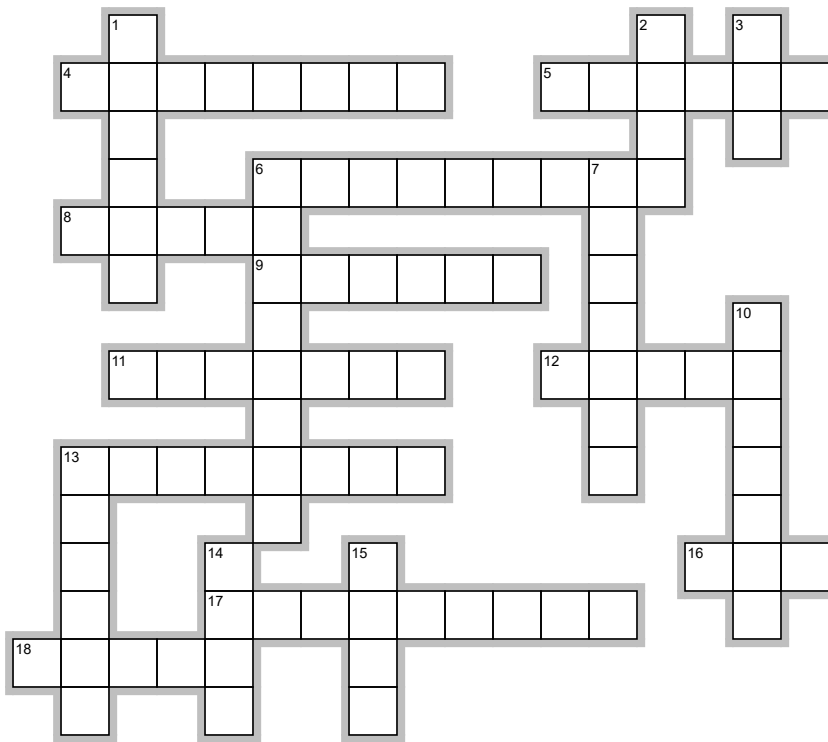
Teacher Instructions
