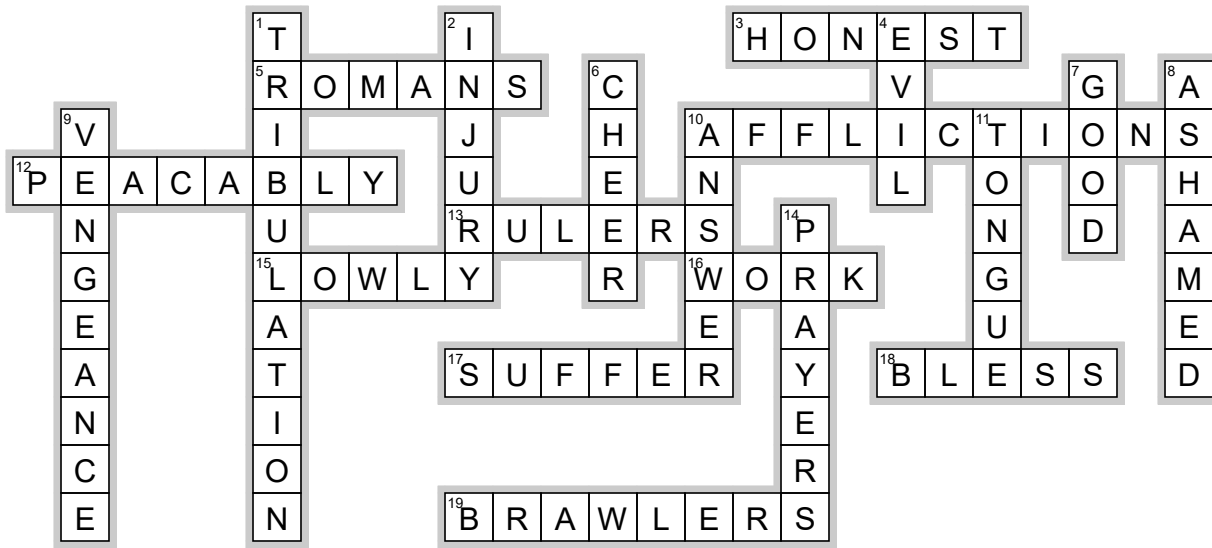


Civics: A Christian Worldview. Crossword Puzzle 4 (15–20 minutes)

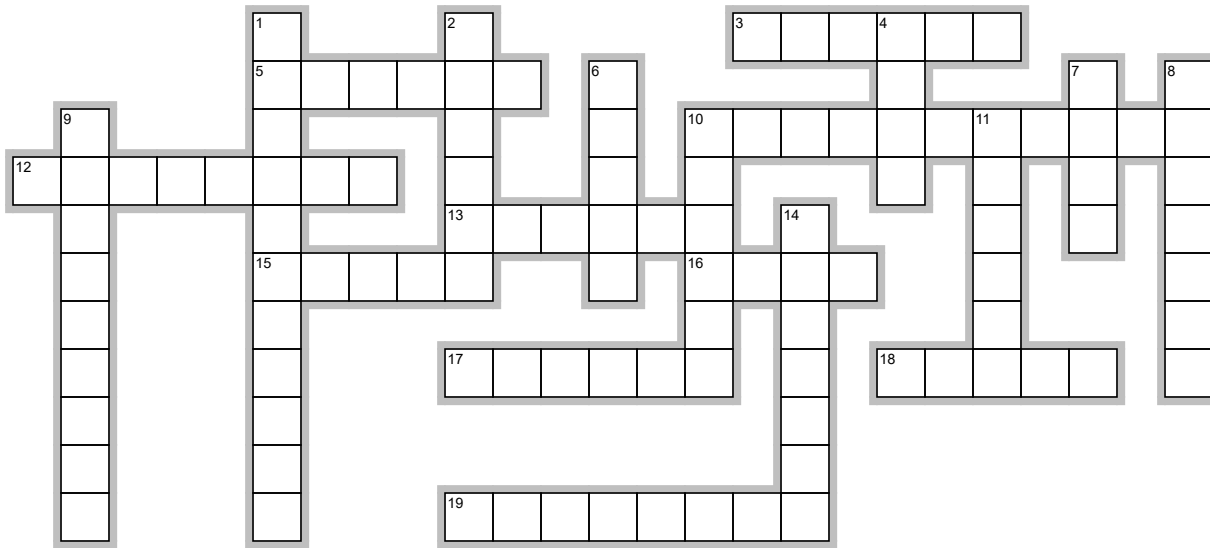
Teacher Instructions
