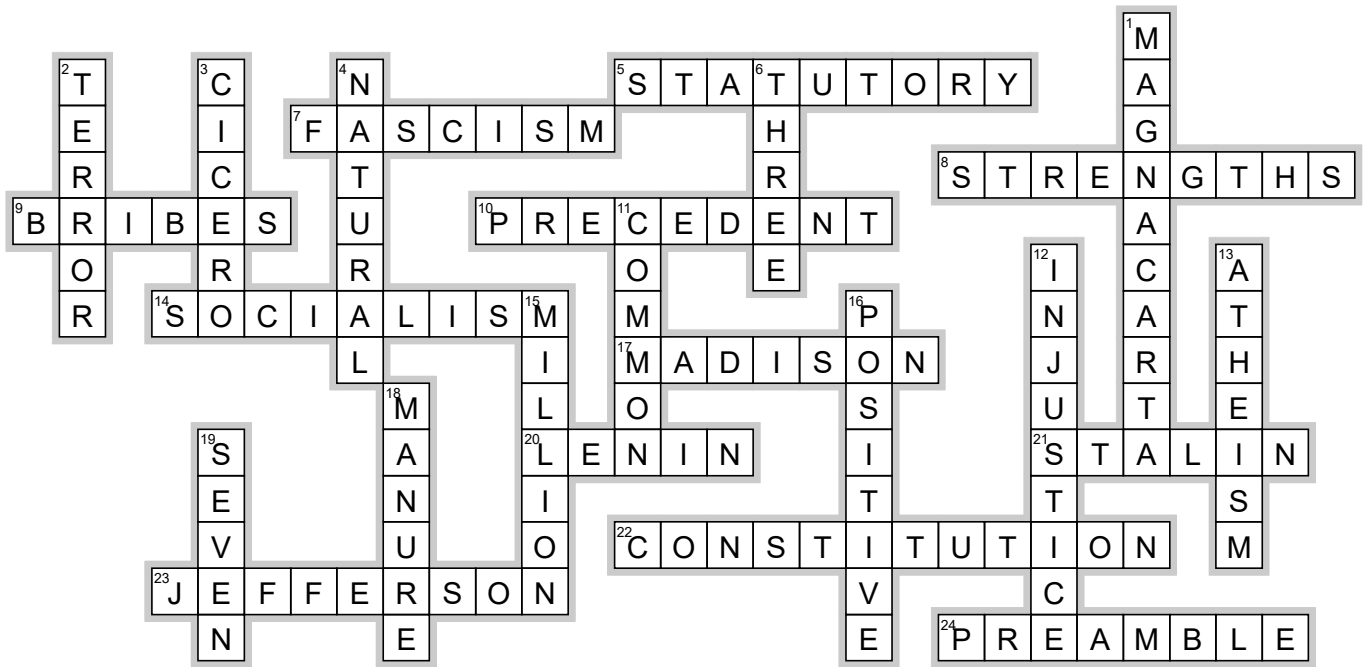


## ***Civics: A Christian Worldview. Crossword Puzzle 6 (20 minutes)***

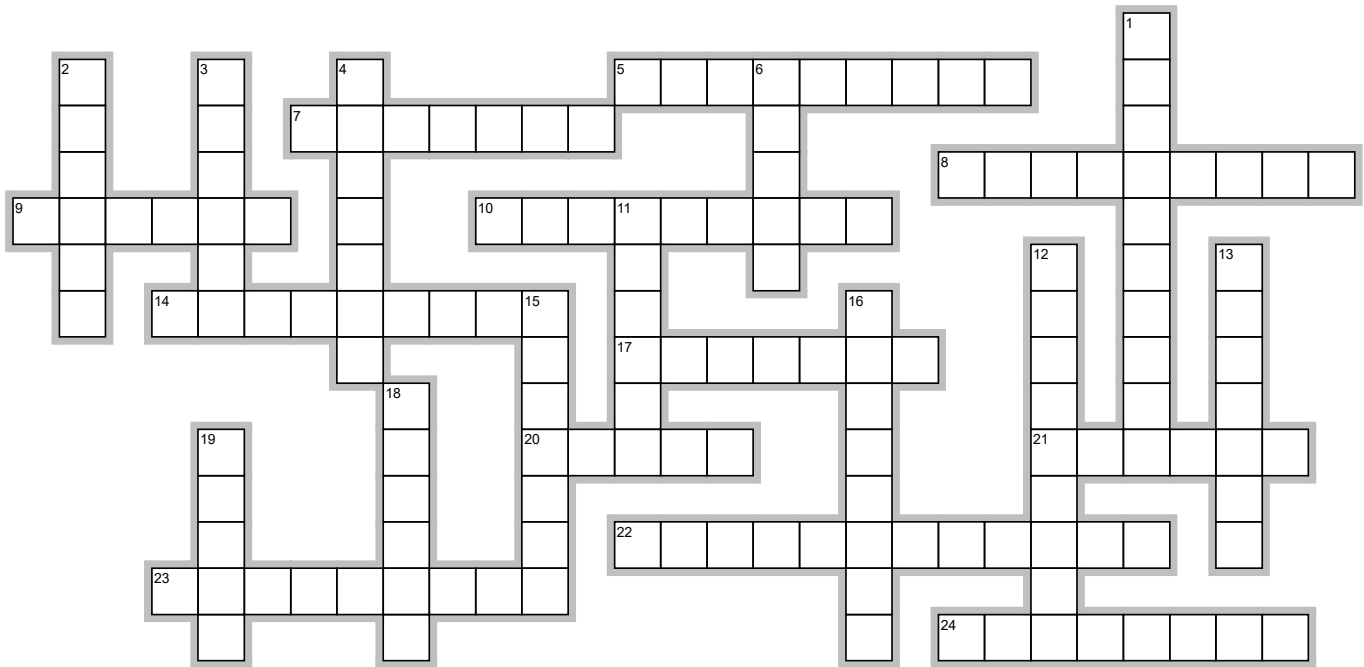
### **Teacher Instructions**
