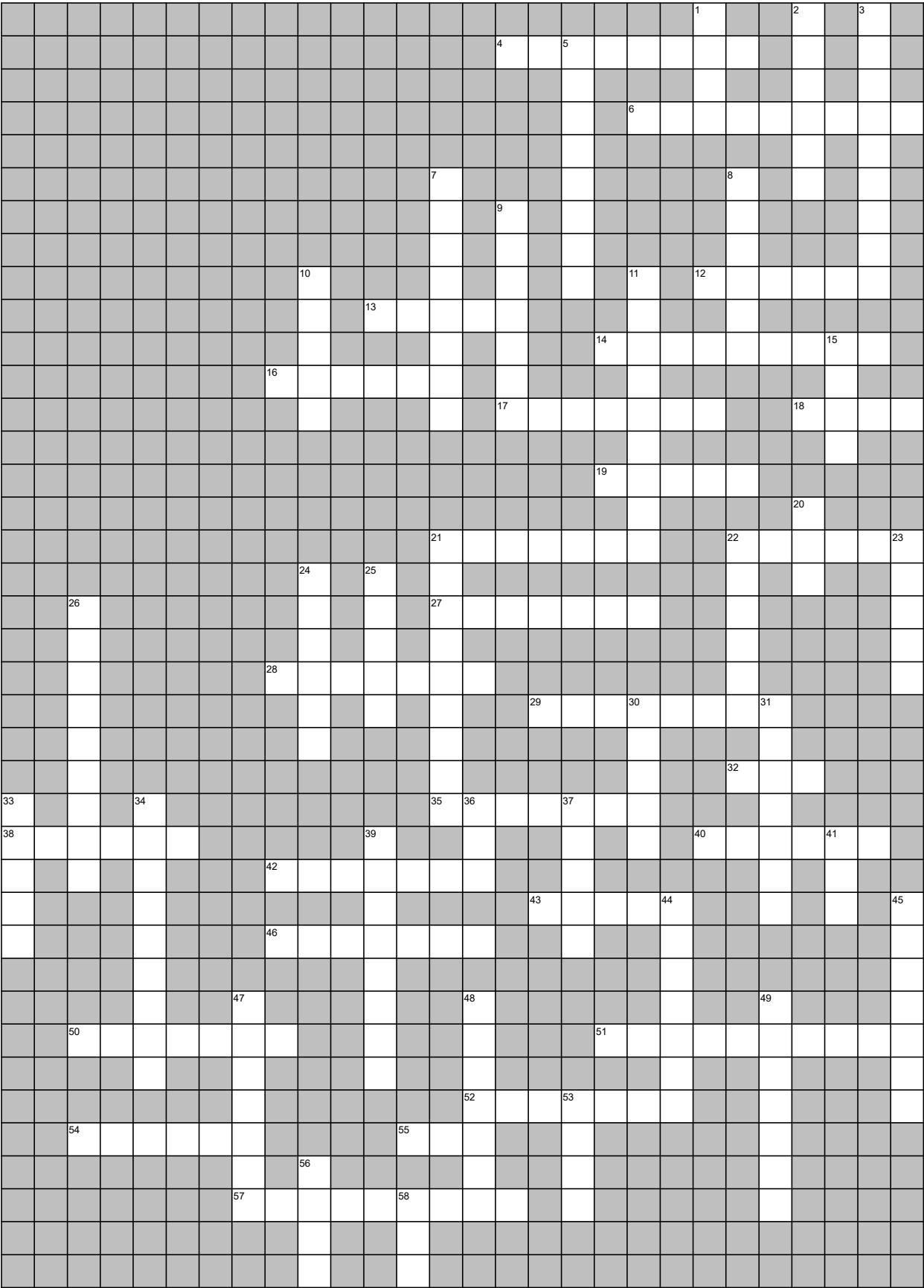


Civics: A Christian Worldview. Crossword Puzzle 8 (30-35 minutes)

Teacher Instructions

1. Print a copy of this page and the Answer Key (Page 2) for yourself.
2. Print a copy of Pages 3 and 4 for each student (front to back, if possible—this time the puzzle is on Page 3, and the clues are on Page 4).
3. Hand out to students. (This crossword is a review for the entire year!)
4. Suggestion 1: Tell students they may use their notes and book if they'd like.
5. Suggestion 2: Students may help each other out by giving hints to each other once they've gone through the puzzle a few times, and if they can't solve certain clues.
6. You can help students on questions, but try to get them to think of the answer by giving clues!
7. Go over the answers when a reasonable time has passed (30-35 minutes).
