

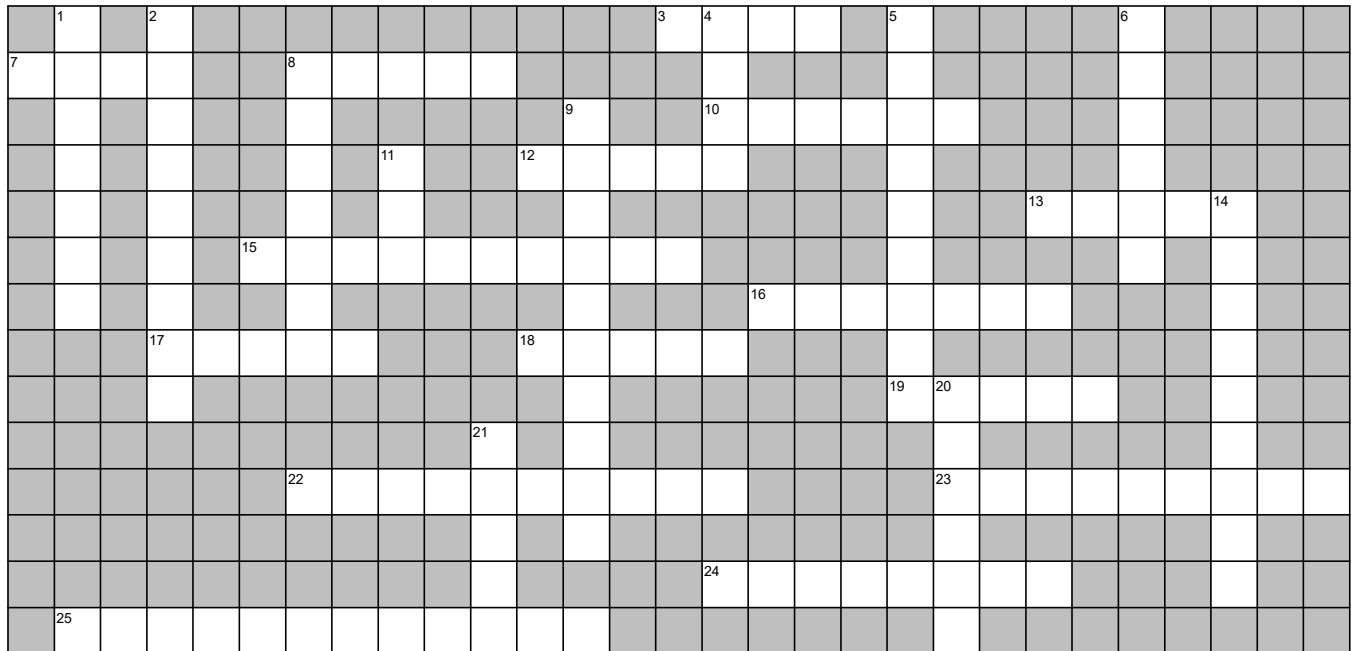
## ***Economics: A Christian Worldview. Crossword Puzzle 4 (20 minutes)***

### **Teacher Instructions**
