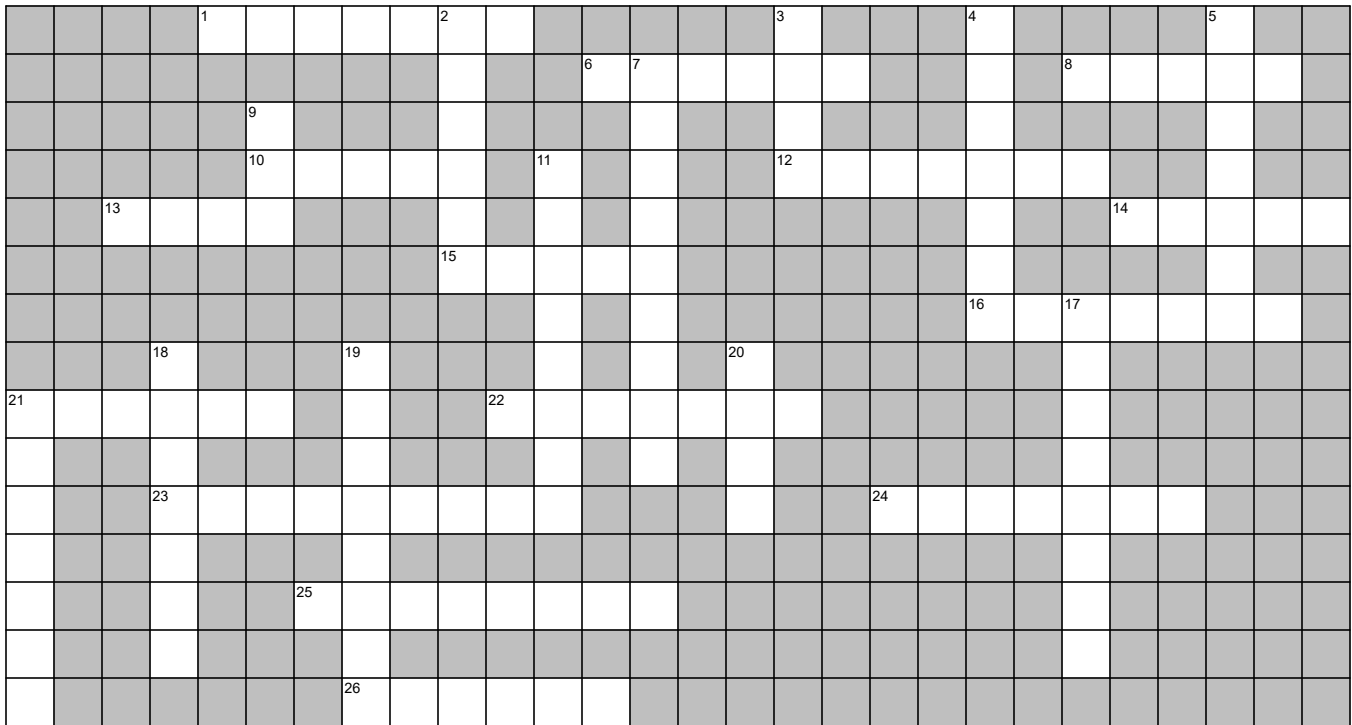


Economics: A Christian Worldview. Crossword Puzzle 6 (20 minutes)
