

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS/KEY

Instructions

1. Ask students if they remember the term “Renaissance Man” from the previous book section (individuals like Leonardo da Vinci or Benjamin Franklin who had talents in many different areas), and ask for a volunteer to explain the term.
2. Tell students to take out a sheet of paper and write down a list of three or four of (a) their skills/talents and (b) their interests. Underneath each skill and interest, have students write a brief explanation of how they could use this skill or interest to serve God and/or mankind. (Give students about 8-10 minutes.)
3. Have students share these in class one at a time, going around the room! (This is also a fun way for students to display some of their own talents and “brag a little without bragging.”) Just have students share one of their talents/interests at a time, then go around the room again to share more.
