**Instructions**

1. **Objective:** Students individually practice their knowledge of American government terms and persons by giving one-word answers to clues, then finding those words in a word search puzzle.

3. Tell students they have 15 minutes to complete! (If they want, they can check their notes or American government book for answers to the clues!)
